

National Handloom Day Celebration on 7th August 2025

Ministry of Textiles is organizing National Handloom Day on 7 August 2025 at Bharat Mandapam, New Delhi. Each year, 7th August is celebrated as National Handloom Day to commemorate the Swadeshi Movement which was launched on this day in 1905. The National Handloom Day is observed annually to honour our handloom weavers and provide impetus to the handloom industry.

2. Handloom is a symbol of our glorious cultural heritage and an important source of livelihood in the country. This is one of the key sectors for women's empowerment, as over 70% of all handloom weavers and allied workers are women.
