Indian Film Festival in Ashgabat, 20-24 January 2026

Embassy of India in Ashgabat, in association with the Ministry of Information & Broadcasting of India and the Ministry of Culture of Turkmenistan, organized an “Indian Film Festival” from 20-24 January 2026 in Ashgabat. Ambassador Bandaru Wilsonbabu and Deputy Minister of Culture of Turkmenistan H.E. Mr. Nursakhet Shirimov jointly inaugurated the Film Festival at “Ashgabat Cinema Theatre” on 20 January 2026.

In his speech, Ambassador recalled the longstanding bonds of friendship and cooperation between India and Turkmenistan and reaffirmed India’s readiness to share its developmental experience and expertise with Turkmenistan, including in the fields of arts and culture. India considers Turkmenistan as a close friend and partner in its “Extended Neighborhood” and the organization of the Indian Film Festival in Ashgabat was a vivid reflection of the vibrant friendship and people-to-people linkages between the two countries.
