CII Partnership Summit 2025, Visakhapatnam (Andhra Pradesh) 14-15 November 2025

The Partnership Summit 2025 has been scheduled to take place from 14-15 November 2025 in Visakhapatnam (Andhra Pradesh).

Organised by the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) in association with the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) in the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India, as well as the Government of Andhra Pradesh, this 30th edition of the Partnership Summit will take place under the overarching theme "Technology, Trust, and Trade: Navigating the New Geoeconomic Order".
